

Record Expungement Checklist

What is Expungement?

Expungement is the removal of records from public inspection. In Maryland, records may be expunged from 1) Motor Vehicle Administration files 2) Police files and 3) Court files. This means background searches should not be able to find the case and the case is removed from the Maryland Public Case Search Website.

Individuals receiving Supplement Security Income (SSI) or Social Security Disability Insurance (SSDI) and who have a criminal record that is preventing them from getting a job (or getting a better job), may be eligible for help getting their record expunged.

Should You Apply?

- Do you have criminal records in the State of Maryland?
- Is your record preventing you from getting a better job than you have now
- Are you currently receiving Social Security benefits?

If you checked all 3 boxes, you are probably eligible to receive **FREE** assistance with expunging your record. We recommend that you **call** Disability Rights Maryland (DRM) formerly Maryland Disability Law Center (MDLC) for further assistance at **410-727-6352 ext. 2515** ask for Kathrine.
