

A U.S. Marine with work experience in cyber, telephony, and radio/satellite communications with skills transferable to cyber security and information technology, Denzil wanted training in IT/Cybersecurity to become a Computer Systems Security Manager.

In April 2022, Denzil had the opportunity to take a course with IBSS (a woman-owned small business specializing in science and IT services) as a pre-apprenticeship to its Registered Apprenticeship program. The course offers certifications in CompTIA Network+, Security+, Linux+, and CySA+. Denzil proved his IT proficiency by passing exams in all four areas and still continues with additional certifications.



He also interviewed and was selected for a coveted position in IBSS' Registered Apprenticeship program. This is a paid program approved by the state of Maryland to increase the pipeline of Cybersecurity professionals and immediate fulltime employment.

Denzil wrote, "This program is a valuable opportunity to accomplish my goals in cybersecurity and to further my formal education. Doing so will allow me to position myself for the best and most lucrative job opportunities.
