- As of 2024 the region's population increased by 0.7% since 2019, growing by 7,678. Population is expected to increase by 0.5% between 2024 and 2029, adding 5,129.
- From 2019 to 2024, jobs declined by 2.5% in Montgomery County, MD from 548,863 to 535,343. This change fell short of the national growth rate of 4.3% by 6.8%. As the number of jobs declined, the labor force participation rate decreased from 71.2% to 67.0% between 2019 and 2024.
- Concerning educational attainment, **27.1% of Montgomery County, MD residents possess a Bachelor's Degree** (5.5% above the national average), and **5.5% hold an Associate's Degree** (3.4% below the national average).
- The top three industries in 2024 are Federal Government, Civilian, Education and Hospitals (Local Government), and Restaurants and Other Eating Places.




Jun 2025 Labor Force Breakdown






Unemployment by Gender



Unemployment by Ethnicity







Job Trends




Montgomery County, MD had a June 2025 unemployment rate of 3.58%, decreasing from 5.92% 5 years before.




Millennials

Montgomery County, MD has 196,344 millennials (ages 25-39). The national average for an area this size is 215,064.




Retiring Soon

Retirement risk is about average in Montgomery County, MD. The national average for an area this size is 319,528 people 55 or older, while there are 324,556 here.




Racial Diversity

Montgomery County, MD has 1.99 violent crimes per 1,000 people. The national rate is 3.54 per 1,000 people.




Property Crime










Top Industry Employment Concentration








Top Industry GRP






Top Occupation Employment Concentration




